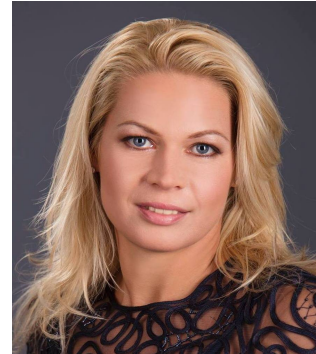
With all my heart I wish all the participants and to Hungary organizers lot of sporting success.

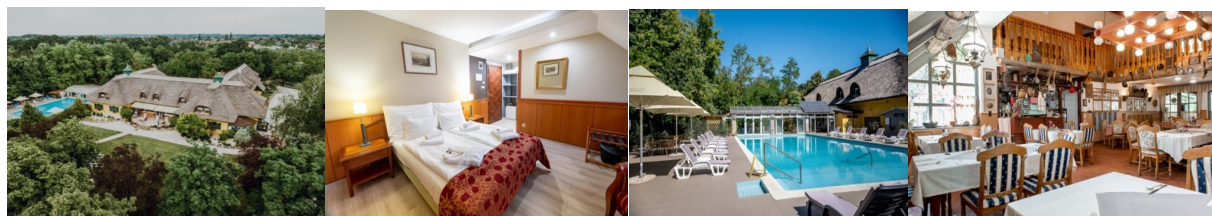
terminals but in a green oasis in Vecses, surrounded by woods and family homes, just 10 minutes from Budapest Liszt Ferenc International Airport.



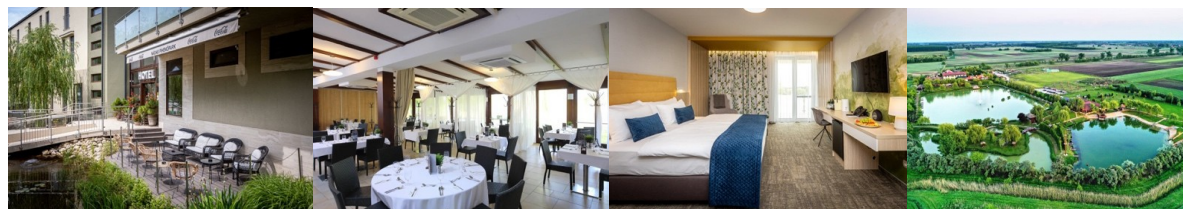

Is an indoor arena located in Monor, Balassi Balint utca 25, 2200

Insurance: It is recommended that all participants must purchase their own medical insurance and personal trip insurance. The competition organizers are taking no liability for these matters. The competitors participate on their own risk, the Chief of the delegation have to sign the enclosed terms of responsibility sheet and return it by March 31st 2026 .

Participants: Members and temporary WSSHrf members Federations and Groups. Federations, Groups and Individuals without registration wishing to participate in the Championships they will have to contact the organizers to arrange the terms of their participation. However such a Federations, Groups and Individuals, must come from countries that do not have a WSSHrf registered member. You can find the member countries of the WSSHrf at: www.wsshrf.org

Registration: At the internet page www.sutazekarate.sk you can register your team composition, competitors, Referees & Judges, VIP and Officials. Federation members can register a maximum of 2 competitors for each age cadet, junior, U21, +18 masters +35, +45 and +55 competitors are permitted for registration. Temporary federations can register maximum 1 competitors for each Championships category. End of registration is 25 May, 2026

Entry fees: fees are divided into two groups. Federations that have paid annual membership fees have a different fee price than those that have not paid annual membership fees. In principle, the basic amount is paid for one competition category in which the competitor participates, if he/she also participates in the next category, an additional fee is paid for that category. The list of entry fees is given in the table below

System: WSSHrf Rules for Kata and Kumite competition will be applied. Full repechage for two third places will be implemented. In the case of time shortage, Kumite bouts can be cut shorter, about 30 seconds. This modification can be applied in Kumite, at the age categories from 14 years to +55years categories.

Referees : Referees with National, Style & International qualification are welcome. Participating Referees should attend pre-Championships briefing and present their Karate passport with the confirmation of an approved license. After briefing, the Referees must pass the theoretical examination regarding the WSSHrf competition rules. At the briefing, the Referee commission will appoint the following: Match area Controller, Appeal jury, deploy Referees and Judges to Tatami. Regular WSSHrf. Federations, Groups have obligation to present minimum one (1) and maximum eight (8) Referees for the Championship, Federations or Groups, who will not present Referees will be penalized by fine of 100€.

IMPORTANT:

- 1. All competitors must be present at the Sport Hall with a minimum of one (1) hour before the start of their competition category.**
- 2. At the opening ceremony all participating teams should be present with at least 6 competitors**
- 3. Competitors which will compete in categories UP to 6.kyu and UP to 4.kyu before line up and starting the competition category must confirm their technical grade by presenting their Karate Passport. The assistant of match are controler will check technical grade, whether they meet the conditions for participation in the given category.**
- 4. After the end of the registration period May 25th 2026 it will not be possible to add to the list of new competitors, coaches. We will publish the list of competitors & Teams timetable for weigh-in and registration on internet site www.sutazekarate.sk**
- 5. Registration and weigh-in in of competitors will take place on Thursday, June 4th 2026, will start from 17.30 in the Sports hall.**
- 6. Time table of the Championships will be available for viewing on the website www.sutazekarate.sk after the end of competitors registration has been completed in Thursday, June, 4th 2026.**

TERMS OF RESPONSIBILITY

Participating Federations and Groups should fill, sign and send back before 31st March, 2026.
